

## Update on Pandemic AH1N1 Influenza-Afghanistan: 10 February 2010

As of today 10 February 2010, the Ministry of Public Health has reported 953 cases of the Pandemic Influenza in the country, including 17 deaths;



MOPH is also tracking pandemic influenza transmission through DEWS reports of the number of cases of acute respiratory infections (ARI) on daily basis from provincial hospitals and on weekly basis from 177 sentinel sites. Currently MOPH DEWS is only testing for H1N1 in the 12 provinces where cases have not been confirmed
